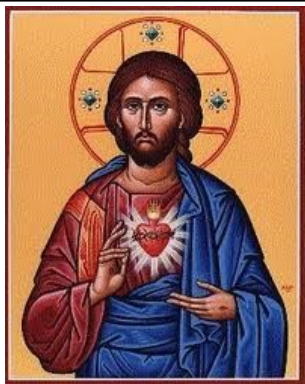

**Answer:** OP Moment Trivia is: **d.**

St. Dominic approached Pope Innocent III in 1215 to obtain approval for his new order. The Pope died before final authority could be obtained. It was a year later in December 1216 that written approval was granted by Pope Honorius III (1148-1227). He also approved the Franciscan Order in 1223. In 1219 he gave the church of Santa Sabina to the Dominicans who took possession in 1220.
