

*Book 2-Part I-Section III-Scapular and Habit Para 26*

Upon a Perpetual Professed member's death, he or she may wear a large scapular over clothing at the time of burial, or the scapular may be folded and placed at the foot of the coffin. Members are granted the privilege to wear the Dominican habit as a shroud, if preferred. In this case, only the lay habit is allowed: namely, the tunic, belt, rosary, scapular, and capuce. The veil and cappa are not included with this privilege. Members wishing to be buried wearing the Dominican habit or symbols are encouraged to complete and appropriately distribute the Burial Preference Declaration Form of the Lay Fraternities of Saint Dominic (*Form A*).
